In anticipation of the Union Gallery's March 15th deadline for exhibition and project proposals for 2016/2017, the gallery will host an informal workshop session facilitated by Ellyn Walker. Portfolio preparation and strong proposal writing are essential parts of applying to any Call for Submission. In this workshop you will learn basic strategies about improving your application materials. Ellyn will review the submission package requirements and provide insight into the art of writing artist statements and CVs, as well as preparing appropriate artwork images and project documentation.

Ellyn Walker is the Research and Programming Assistant at the Union Gallery and a PhD student, in Cultural Studies. She curated the exhibition *Re-mixed: Reconfiguring the Imaginary* by Vancouver artist Sonny Assu, which is currently on display at the Union Gallery.
