Selected poets will be invited to participate in the event at the Union Gallery (1st Floor Stauffer Library, Queen's University), on April 6th from 4:30-6pm. Poets will have approximately five minutes to perform their piece(s). Members of the public are invited to attend this free poetry reading.

We are seeking submissions on the theme of ***Time***. The jury will select poets based on the work submitted in the application.

Guidelines for Submissions

Please note: This is a juried event and poets will be notified by Friday, March 31st if their application was successful.

All submissions should be sent to ugallery@queensu.ca, with the following attached in the email as a single attachment (.doc/.docx or .pdf are preferred):

1. A brief introduction and short one or two paragraph biography, outlining any experience with writing/performing poetry (e.g. community involvement, campus clubs participation, local open mic, etc.)
2. A sample of 1-3 pages of your own poetry
3. Any relevant writing experience/publications/literary CV

Submissions are due by **Tuesday, March 28th at 4:30pm**.
