

Call for Submissions: Union Gallery Vitrine Project



For the past three years the Union Gallery Vitrine Projects has featured curated projects by Queen's University undergraduate and graduate student artists and curators in its vitrine venue located just outside the gallery. During 2018-2019 the Union Gallery will be showcasing curated projects to be held in conjunction with the gallery exhibits and invites students and local artists or curators to propose an exhibition for this space.

In keeping with the gallery mandate the project proposals should reflect on contemporary visual and interdisciplinary art and art practices. The projects are installed in our two-sided display case venue situated just outside the main entrance to the gallery. Previous curators have chosen to present a thematic display from contemporary artist books and catalogues housed in the gallery's substantial archive; a print exhibit of artist zines or multiples. You may also propose an alternative use for the space.

Please keep in mind the limited space of the vitrine. Approximate dimensions of usable interior space:

Height: 105 centimetres (41 inches)

Width: 89 centimetres (35 inches)

Shelf depth: 5.5 cm. (2.25 in.) – 6 shelves; shelf height: 26.7cm. (10.5 in.)

Submission Requirements:

1. Proposal description/concept – 1 page maximum. Clearly describe the proposed exhibition or project. Please submit as a pdf. - **Note: if you would like to discuss your project before applying please contact jp14@queensu.ca.**
2. Artist/curator statement – 100-250 words
3. Artist bio – between 50-100 words.
4. If applicable, please attach a list of supporting materials and/or images.
5. Submit above materials to ugallery@queensu.ca (ATTN: Jocelyn Purdie).

Please note: while the vitrine is locked, there is no security in the foyer area, which is open 24 hours. Projects are not insured by the gallery.
